Since 1981, the Fine Arts Center of Kershaw County has provided a School Arts enrichment program for the schools in Kershaw County. School Arts provides a professional artist to be in residence in each school for at least one and up to eight weeks to perform, to teach, and to inspire student creativity through hands on experiences with the arts.

The School Arts program is partially funded by the Upton Foundation, the Kershaw County School Board, and the South Carolina Arts Commission that receives support for the National Foundation for the Arts. However, at least one third of the funds needed for the program must be raised by appealing to the community.

This school year a resident artist taught your child and his classmates. An evaluation from the teacher attests to the educational and artistic enrichment this program provides.
