## PreSchool Art Camp

Preschoolers age 4 through those who have not completed 1st grade

Campers explore a variety of art media. Each two day session has its own unique theme: first "Down On the Farm" and then "Pirate Treasure." The program is a blend of guided explorations at intriguing "arts centers" (such as the costume box) and group activities designed to spur curiosity. A mid-morning snack is provided.

## Registration Procedures:

**Registration Art Camp & Preschool Art Camp:**  
If you register a week or more before the beginning of a session and we reach our minimum enrollment, we guarantee an opening for your child. We may be able to find a spot for your child up to the very beginning of a camp session, but every year we have had to turn away last minute campers because we were completely full.

**Theatre Camps and Adult & Teen Clay Classes**  
If you register a week or more before the beginning of a session and we reach our minimum enrollment, the class will occur. If we have insufficient enrollment, we will notify you and refund your payment. We do not remind students of class start dates.

### Don't wait until it's too late!!!

Instructors are hired based on the number of campers attending a session. The FAC reserves the right to cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment or compelling circumstances. Enrollees will be contacted only in the event of cancellation and their fees refunded.
